A journalist and writer who has worked for various publications and media including as a foreign correspondent for the Daily Mail and for BBC News in England and ABC News in Australia. She was named Business Writer of the Year, has a Churchill Fellowship and is an established author with books published by Pelham Books, Rigby Books and The History Press. She has spent a lifetime involved in women's aviation and especially in air sports; she was British women's freefall Champion,

a member of the British Parachute Team, founder, and team leader of the world's first all-girl parachute display team, giving displays both across the UK and internationally. She was also a keen balloonist, a member of the Australian ballooning team, second overall female at the world ballooning champions, a commercial balloon pilot and ran a ballooning school and a very successful passenger carrying operation.
