# April 2025 to March 2026 Why not try your luck?

Would you like to 'Take a Chance'?

Entering is easy, simply purchase your number(s) and they will be entered into each monthly draw from the beginning of the lottery term (April 2025 to March 2026) (or the date you purchase your number(s) if later that the beginning of the term) and also entered in the special draw which takes place at the Annual Meeting. The first draw using newly allocated numbers will take place in April 2025.

Prize money depends on number of members taking part and will be notified at the time of the first draw but over the year will be half of the money paid.

Numbers allocated will be emailed to the individual or the WI Secretary.

N.B. Charity law requirements mean that only individual members may enter, numbers CANNOT be bought by WIs.

## Rules for LSFWI Take a Chance Lottery 2025-2026

- 1. LSFWI's Lottery will be known as the Take a Chance Lottery and will be registered at WI Office, Pattinson House, Oak Park, East Road, Sleaford NG34 7EQ
- 2. The purpose of the Take a Chance Lottery is to raise funds for LSFWI and all proceeds raised, after provision of prizes and expenses, will go to Federation funds.
- 3. The subscription is £5.00 per number per entry per lottery term. The lottery term is  $1^{st}$  April  $-31^{st}$  March each year.
- 4. Application for participation must be made to the LSFWI Finance Officer, or person authorised by the Board of Trustees of the Federation. Participation is open to all individual LSFWI members.
- 5. Every entry number must be registered in the name of an individual bone fide member of the Federation.
- 6. Each participant will receive a copy of the Rules and their own registered number.
- 7. All monies must be paid in full before entry into a draw. The numbers of fully paid-up members will be entered into all the monthly draws in the lottery term.
- 8. There will be no price reduction for members entering the lottery after the start of the lottery term; their numbers will be entered into each monthly draw after payment is made, up to the end of the lottery term. Numbers will not be carried over into the next term.
- 9. There will be draws for 50% of the capital deposit each year. The draws for the prizes will be arranged at the discretion of the Board of Trustees and held in the presence of at least five people.
- 10. Winners will be recorded in the Board of Trustees meeting minutes and in the newsletter each month.
- 11. Prize money will be paid into the winning members' bank accounts.
- 12. The decision of the Board of Trustees of the Federation is final in any matters requiring adjudication. The Board has the power to amend or revoke these rules after 28 days' notice has been given to all members.
- 13. The Promoter of the Take a Chance Lottery shall be the Secretary or agent for the time being of the Federation.
